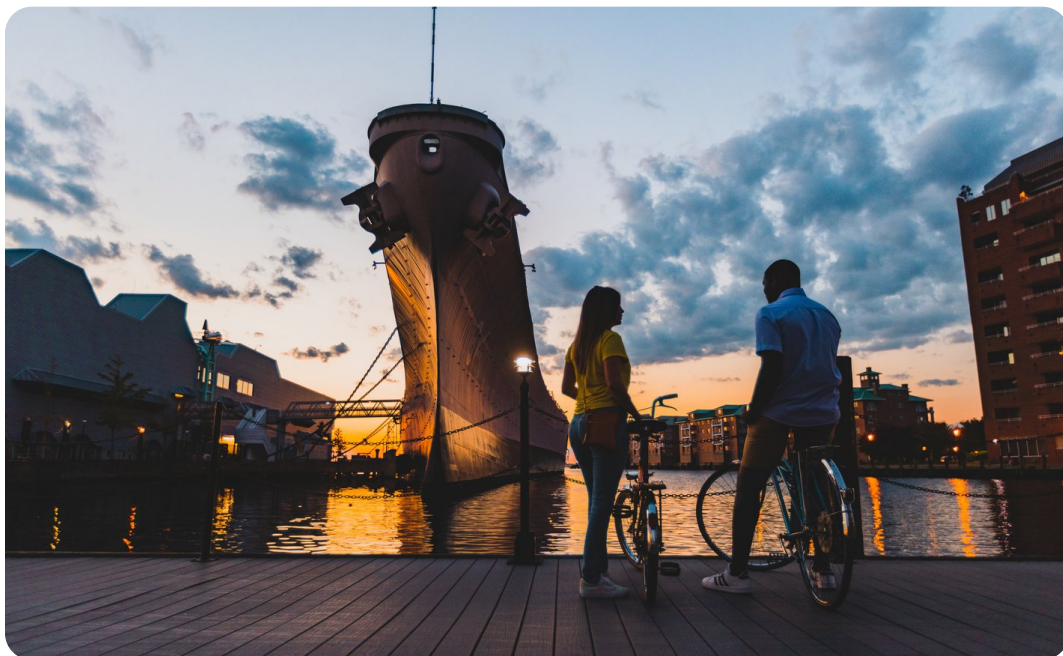
ART LOVERS
